DRA Trail Tamers care for more than 30 miles of trails in the greater Damariscotta River region. Trail Tamers meet on the third Thursday of the month, plus an occasional Tuesday or Saturday, May to October, from **9:00 to noon**. Participants should bring water bottle, work gloves, bug repellent – wear long pants and solid footwear – head and eye protection as needed. May 8 (Tuesday) Big Barn Blowout – help clean up and clear out the DRA barn (Meet at DRA Farm)

May 17 (Thursday) Hart Family Heritage Trail – anchor cedar walkways, reopen overgrown spur, clean up existing trails (Meet at DRA Farm)

June 2 (Saturday) National Trails Day – join thousands of volunteers around the nation working to improve local trails (Meet at DRA Farm)

June 21 (Thursday) Dodge Point – clear brush along Ravine Trail, improve Shore Trail (Meet at Dodge Point)

July 10 (Tuesday) Marsh River Bog – install an educational boardwalk onto the bog (Meet at DRA Farm)

July 19 (Thursday) Marsh River Bog – complete installation of educational boardwalk (Meet at DRA Farm)

August 16 (Thursday) NORGAL Preserve – install signs, mark boundaries (Meet at PWA's Bearce-Allen Preserve trailhead)

September 20 (Thursday) River ~ Link – clear new section of trail west of Dodge Point (Meet at Dodge Point, allow an extra hour)

October 18 (Thursday) River ~ Link continued (Meet at Dodge Point)
